

Lab Safety Rules

- 1) Wear safety goggles when working in the lab to protect your eyes.
- 2) Wear a lab coat or lab apron to protect your clothing and gloves (when needed) to protect your hands.
- 3) Keep the materials you are using in the science experiment away from your mouth, nose, and eyes. Do not touch your face while doing the science experiment or when cleaning up afterwards.
- Tie back long hair, secure loose clothing and do not wear dangling jewelry.
- 5) NEVER taste anything during a science activity in the lab.
- 6) Know where the safety equipment (like a first-aid kit, eyewash station, fire blanket) is located inside the lab.
- 7) Do not play with lab equipment.
- 8) Tell the teacher IMMEDIATELY if you get hurt, spill something, or something gets broken.
- 9) Do not eat or drink anything while in the lab.
- 10) Clean the work area and wash your hands with soap and water after the experiment is finished.
